Mazafati is one of the most popular varieties of dates produced in Iran. It is also one of the most delicious varieties of dates worldwide. This kind of date is soft and originates from most parts of Kerman, Hormozgan, and Sistan and Baluchistan. The most desirable and delicious kind of Mazafati dates is grown in Southern part of Iran, city of Bam. The cultivation area in Bam and its suburbs is about 28000 hectares, and 120,000 metric tons is harvested annually. These dates are highly demanded both in domestic and international markets. Also, it is one of the most exported varieties of dates. As it is soft and juicy and has a favourable taste, it is used in a variety of fresh cuisines.

This date variety is one of the main products of MPND company mostly presented by Kimia Gold brand. It can be supplied in the market with high quality and in various packages. The main quantity of this product is exported

Rabbi Dates, extremely popular in both domestic and international markets, are one of the most featured types of dates in Baluchistan and the most important and commercial dates in that area. This date variety is unique and delicious and very similar to the Piarom dates. Rabbi has a semi-dried texture, because of which is pretty durable to be preserved for a long time.

In pollination period, farmers in Sistan and Balochistan cover their dates clusters with bags woven by palm leaves, because of their high vulnerability. Then, they let them stay on the palms till all of the products pass through the Rutab stage and turn to dates. Having passed the ripening process naturally on the palm, the dates will abound with natural sugars and minerals. Later, the dates cluster is separated along with its protective cover and it is sent to the factory for washing and sorting. Once the washing process is finished and the sorting is done, it is delivered to the market.

Also, this date is mainly known in Russia as "Arab Dates".

The taste of Lulu dates is a bit similar to Piarom dates, but it is more affordable and more economical as far as the price is concerned. It is a high quality date, dark brown in color, and rich in flesh with pretty small seed.

One type of dates which is produced in Iran is called Sayer (Stamaran). This variety is specific to Khuzestan province and covers more than %80 of the cultivated areas of the province.

Its semi-dryness and its thick skin have prolonged its shelf life and have made it one of the most exported varieties of dates. The semi-dried Stamaran date is one of the most important export dates in Iran, comprising %45 of Iran's dates export. These dates are used in various food industries such as biscuits, beverages, cakes, sweets, juice, pickles, vinegar, and dates-nectar. This kind of date comes in various grades namely Super select, Select, B, GAQ and FAQ, that all of these are presented in two types: pitted and unpitted. Also, this type of date is extremely immune to storage conditions, so high temperature and humidity make the least changes in its quality. The moisture content of this date is usually around %14 and they are sorted before being packaged for export.

Medjool is typically elongated in shape, and often it has a dehydrated appearance. Most varieties of this date available in stores are dried, but fresh dates are also available in some import stores and markets in the regions where they grow. The majority of these dates is produced in the Middle East and exported to all parts of the world. They are not only nutritionally dense dates but also have a long shelf life in their dried forms.
